



## NOTICE

On January 16, 2023, work will be starting on Deerfoot Trail near 64 Avenue NE to make improvements that will help ensure current and future traffic needs are met, and that travel times and overall safety are improved for the travelling public.

***Please be advised that travel times to and from your business may be temporarily impacted during construction as a result of your proximity to this work.***

It is recommended that you plan ahead and give yourself extra time to reach your destination when travelling on Deerfoot Trail. Where possible, take an alternate route to help reduce impacts to your commute.

## WHAT IS HAPPENING?



### OVERNIGHT WORK

From **January 16 - January 18** overnight work will be required to facilitate improvements to Deerfoot Trail. Working overnight will help to reduce construction impacts.



### TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES

From **January 16 - January 18**, Northbound Deerfoot Trail will be reduced to two lanes between the hours of **9:00pm and 5:00am** between McKnight Boulevard and 64 Avenue NE to allow for overnight work.



### SPEED LIMIT REDUCTION

The speed limit will be reduced on portions of Deerfoot Trail to accommodate construction activities. Posted speed limits may change over the course of construction, please be aware and obey posted speed limits and construction signage.
