

Deerfoot Trail Improvements

Sanitary sewer main relocation to 12 Street S.E.

April 2025

Project scope

The Deerfoot Trail Improvements project includes several improvement areas along Deerfoot Trail, including widening the highway and adding a lane in both directions north of Glenmore Trail.

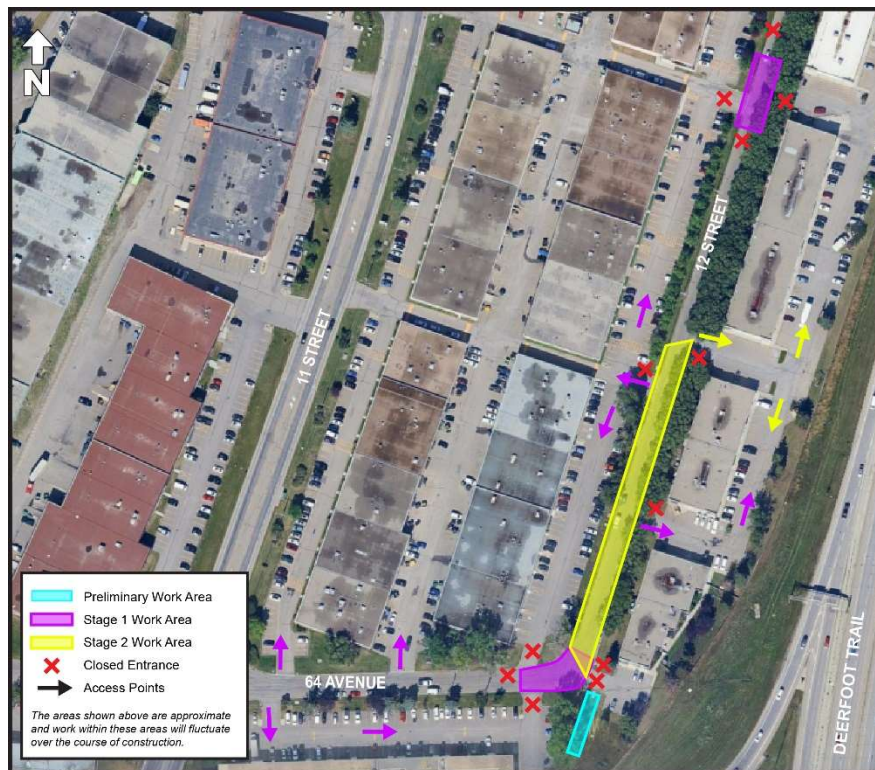
The work requires relocating a large sanitary sewer line from the west side of the Deerfoot highway right-of-way to 12 Street S.E. The line is a major part of the City of Calgary's sewer system, moving effluent between the Fish Creek and Bonnybrook sewage treatment plants.

In addition to relocating the sanitary sewer main, the project will include reconstructing the road, storm drainage and related curbs and gutters on 12 Street S.E.

The Deerfoot Trail Improvements project is being delivered by Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors (ATEC) and their contractor, Aecon, in consultation with The City of Calgary.

Staged construction to minimize business impacts

The work will be completed in approximately ten stages working from south to north to maintain access to businesses, driveways and parking lots.



Stage 1 is anticipated to begin in May. During construction, crews will be working Monday-Saturday between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. with nighttime paving shifts to ensure timely completion.

Construction impacts include temporary business access changes, temporary lane closures and detours, equipment noise, vibrations, dust and temporary loss of street parking. All utility services will be maintained during this time.

Road and utility construction is dependent on weather and other factors, and the schedule may be subject to change.

Why 12 Street S.E.

ATEC, Aecon and The City assessed alignment options for relocating the sanitary sewer main – including the east side of the Deerfoot Trail corridor, 11 Street S.E. and 12 Street S.E.

Based on the overall complexity and constructability of the project, constructability, and increased environmental and technical risks with the east Deerfoot Trail and 11 Street S.E. alternatives, The 12 Street S.E. represented the least impactful route and was selected for the relocation.

Project updates

Regular construction updates in advance of each stage, including anticipated start dates and timelines, will be provided throughout the duration of the project.
